Spectacular birds live carefree on the sanctuary island of **Tiririri Matangi**, reachable on a 75-minute ferry ride from downtown Auckland.

Watch out for morepork, New Zealand's only surviving owl, on **Rangitoto Island**.

Motuihe Island is a haven for reptiles such as tuatara. ook out.

Snapper and stingray frequent the waters around Rakino Island, accessed by a 45-minute ferry trip from downtown Auckland.
